

## **First Email from S. GirmaTSION:**

*I read some of your comments about Ethiopia being a Kingdom of God. Since this is strange for me, can you come up with a fact from the Bible, which can support your idea? Hope to hear from you soon.*

## **Our Response to the First Email from S. Girmatsion:-**

Here is the brief answer to your question that require facts from the Bible which support our claim rendering Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God.

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## **Second Email from S. GirmaTSION:**

*I will try to look to the book you mentioned. As I have mentioned in previous email I have seen and read some of your writing, but still I couldn't grab the point, which you can quote clearly from bible that....*

- 1. Ethiopia is the Kingdom of God.*
- 2. Mary the Mother of Jesus is Ethiopian. For me according to the Bible, Mary was a Hebrew and her genealogy was written when Jesus genealogy was written in Luke.*
- 3. No mention of her to be Ethiopian. She was a relative of Elisabeth, who was of the lineage of Aaron (Luke 1:36).*

*Second God's purpose is not to establish earthly kingdom (Ethiopian Kingdom), it is a heavenly kingdom which Jesus is the king. God's kingdom is a theocracy, a government ruled by a divine being. As I understand a kingdom on earth is a prototype to heavenly kingdom. Christ brought many things when He arrived, including the good news of the gospel, announcing for the first time that the*

*kingdom of God also included a spiritual realm. In fact, it is actually for this spiritual realm of the kingdom of God that the earthly realm exists. For the inhabitants of the spiritual Kingdom of God are to be adopted from the earthly kingdom. Therefore the kingdom of God turns out to be both in heaven and on the earth. Both of which we can consider very real places.*

*Third I don't know if you can come with a quote, but I couldn't find a single verse that God spoke good things about Ethiopia. People usually quote Amos 9:7 to show that we Ethiopians are equal with Israel in the eyes of God. If you read it, the whole chapter, and understand it in context, does it show that in God's eye Ethiopia and Israel equal in blessing or when God going to smite Israel because of her sinfulness?*

*Or Ps 68:31 that Ethiopia is going to stretch her hands to God. Here also it shows that Ethiopia as a gentile nation which was out of the covenant will come to God at the time of end times (bible scholars agree that the end time starts from Jesus earthly ministry) and accepts the gospel.(Gospel meaning the good news that salvation is only by believing the son of God, Jesus, like the Ethiopian eunuch in Acts 8).*

## **Our Response to the Second Email from S. GirmaTSION:-**

I would like to express the view, from the perspective of Our Ethiopian Tewah'do Faith of the Holy Covenant, with regard to some of your remarks stated in your email.

1. All your questions and your observations, including the biblical quotations, outlined in your present email are sufficiently answered and fully dealt with in those books and publications mentioned in my earlier email. The book published in English and entitled "Ethiopia: The Classic Case" as well as those in Ethiopic were meant to serve and help persons like you understand deeply and comprehensively the Biblical Facts and Messages about Ethiopia and Ethiopians, as well as about The Holy Virgin Mary and The Kingdom of God, thus to endow those interested and dedicated persons with the Divine Knowledge of Ethiopianhood.

However, for anyone to be eligible for such Heavenly Privilege, that person ought to be inspired and guided by The Holy Spirit. And

for that individual to attain such eminent status of becoming the Sanctuary of the Holy Spirit, he or she, like those Biblical Figures of the Old and New Testaments, should maintain the True Ethiopian Tewah'do Faith of the Holy Covenant manifest in his or her **"worship of God in Truth and Spirit."**

2. If we initiate to engage ourselves in a dialogue pertaining to such infinite matter in question, as you seem to be wanting to pursue, it would mean to start all over again the whole process of the course of action that brought us to the stage where we are today: The objective already achieved by the Facts and Messages conveyed through those books and publications aforementioned.

3. The Bible is only a small drop of the account that relates about the Truth of God told and recorded by few faithful. It does not cover even the whole thing that pertains to humans, let alone the one that is ascribed to God. The testimony of this truth is asserted in the Gospel of John 21/25 that reads: **"And there are also many other things that Jesus did, which if they were written one by one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that would be written."**

The Ethiopian Case, likewise, is not treated wholly even fractionally there in the Bible. The Bible is a collection of sacred documents predominantly centered on Jewish people who were originally pagans or gentiles or idol worshippers up until the conversion of Abram to Ethiopianhood with a change of name to Abraham by the Ethiopian MelkiZedeq.

Please note that the term Ethiopianhood is a designation given to all those who worship the One God in the Holy Trinity. As such, it is equivalent to the title of "The Children of God" as contrasted to "the children of humans" who are prone to succumb to Evil.

Ethiopians who live in the Realm of Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God, believe that their predecessors and themselves are the **Incarnate Bible**. So, we give precedence and dominance to what God, in accordance with His Prophetic Word (Jer. 31/31-34; Heb. 8/8-13), inscribed on the human hearts, over and above what is written in manuscripts.

Accordingly, The Holy Spirit continues up to now and presently and forever to inspire and guide His True Believers (Ethiopians) to live up to the precepts of the Holy Covenant, and then to reveal and propagate (speak and write) the Divine Truth, Mysteries and Deeds, about Ethiopia Who was finally personified by The Virgin Mary, The Mother of God.

4. If you claim to be a Christian, you simply have to demonstrate to yourself and to God as well as to your fellow humans, **through your Faith and your Deed**, that you qualify for such status. That is all what you need to do to prove the truthfulness and genuineness of your claim. You do not need to quote verses from the Bible in order to verify who you are. Is it not so?

The same principle applies to Ethiopia and Ethiopians. You do not need to expect the Bible that covers particular periods of time and history of certain people to embrace the whole domain of Creation of God, including

the specifics of The Virgin Mary as an Ethiopian and Ethiopia as The Kingdom of God. But, you simply demonstrate their true identity and integrity, constitution (make-up) and achievement in accordance with the Word of God. You only need to show and verify whether they live upto the precepts laid down by their Creator. Yes, what is needed is simply to prove whether they have attained the qualifications in Faith and Deed that would make them what they claim to be.

This assertion could be defined in the following short term: The mere fact that Ethiopia and the Ethiopians, from the time of Adam and Eve, and under the Leadership of their consummate personifications, The Virgin Mary and Her Son God Jesus Christ, remain the sole embodiments and faithful custodians of all Seven Holy Covenants enshrined in the Bible qualify them for that heavenly claim. Such qualification and the attainment of such exalted status singled them out from among the whole humanity. And this truth is described in greater detail in the books and publications mentioned elsewhere, more concisely in the Forum of Faith of our website.

Let me pose, in this regard, one relevant subject matter for your serious consideration that concerns you directly as a Christian let alone as an Ethiopian: Are you aware of the reality that humanity in general and the Christendom (Churches comprising the clergy and the laity, including you) in particular currently strive to serve two masters: two kingdoms (governments), of God and of humans, of Christ and of the devil simultaneously in diametrical contradiction of the guideline ordained by God? (Mtt. 6/24)

5. Just to give you a hint about the issue in discussion: Try to perceive and understand positively the Word that Our Lord Jesus Christ uttered when He responded to the same question you are currently presenting. Here is the Divine Word: **Now, when He [Jesus Christ] was asked by the Pharesees when the Kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The Kingdom of God does not come with observation, nor will they say, 'See Here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, The Kingdom of God is within you!"** (Lk. 17/20-21)

Hence, the Fellowship of those individual True Ethiopians of The Holy Covenant who believe that The Kingdom of God is within each one of them constitutes **Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God.**

6. Who are these people whom you refer to as Bible scholars? Do you really mean these people to be the learned, the scribes and the doctors of the books who misused, misconstrued and misrepresented the True Word of God, especially that relates to Ethiopia and The Ethiopians? You seem to accept and follow their interpretations and attempt to convince us to accept their manipulations.

Just take the verses you yourself quoted concerning Ethiopia and the Ethiopians for example: Ps 68:31 and Amos 9:7. Is the interpretation you gave the proper one that a True Ethiopian renders to these biblical verses? Isn't the latter verse, even as it stands in the versions other than the authentic

Ge'ez one, quite explicit in revealing and conveying the True Message that God recognized, loved and preferred the Children of Ethiopia well before and above the Children of Israel? In fact and more importantly, I do not think you realized the reality that the Ge'ez verse does not present the Divine Message in interrogative term as all other versions do, but rather in the positive and affirmative statement.

7. The distinctive feature and name presented to humans to make their own individual preference in the eyes of God is one and only one: and that is either to be "Children of God" or "Children of men". From Mother Ethiopia! To The Children Ethiopian! About Ethiopianhood!". All the detailed and analytical explanation of the aforementioned is contained therein.

I hope the next email that I may receive from you, if any, will emerge only after your perusal of the whole relevant materials referred to in the foregoing paragraphs.

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### **Third E-mail from S. GirmaTSION:**

I don't think you understand well my intent. When I sent you my request, I thought I ask a simple question that needs a simple answer.

As I understand the Bible, Jesus taught to His disciples a simple lesson. Believe in me, and you will be saved, and God confirmed this message through the apostles. When we see the messages of the New Testament; it said if you are in Christ you are a **new creation**. (Not become Ethiopian or Ethiopian hood). Even if you said no need of quoting the bible, I am going to quote it to support my idea; since bible is the source of all truths...

*"... You have put off the old man with his deeds, and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him"  
(Colossians 3:9-10).*

*"For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ" (Galatians 3:26-27).*

*"... God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery*

*among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory" (Colossians 1:27).*

*"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new" (2 Corinthians 5:17).*

*"I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God who loved me and gave Himself for me" (Galatians 2:20).*

When our minds and hearts are transformed by the Holy Spirit, we "put on Christ." Paul describes this dramatic change in our hearts and minds as Jesus Christ living within us. We "put off the old man with his deeds" and "put on the new man." We are "renewed" in knowledge and in the spirit of our minds. As the children of God we become "in Christ" a truly new creation. God transforms us into His own family—His sons and daughters (2 Corinthians 6:18). (Please note that there no mention of Ethiopian hood in the Bible.)

The Holy Spirit will make us be a new creation in spirit; He will not make us Ethiopians. As stated in the bible **Ga 3:28** **"There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus."**

Did the bible say, you will become Ethiopian if you are saved? My simple question to your email is where did you get this idea of Ethiopian and Ethiopian hood? I don't think you are against the word of Bible, if you think there is any authoritative message above the Bible, then you and I are in different sphere and I think no need to discuss, but if Bible is the highest authoritative then you have to come with a supportive quote that can support your Ethiopian hood idea.

Let me add a point; what is sin? Sin is anything we prefer over Christ or God. Based on your teaching you prefer Ethiopia over Christ. You worship the created and teach people to follow your teaching.

Rom 1:25 "They exchanged the truth of God for a lie and worshiped and served the creation rather than the Creator, who is blessed forever! Amen" Don't you think you are the same as "They"

Stating my idea above, let me try to reply to your email, with my understanding of bible...

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However, for anyone to be eligible for such Heavenly Privilege, that person ought to be inspired and guided by The Holy Spirit. The sealing work of the Holy Spirit is the basis for our eternal security. The three phases of salvation are given in Eph. 1:13.

Eph. 1:13,14, In Him, you also, after listening to the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation-- having also believed, you were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is given as a pledge of our inheritance, with a view to the redemption of God's own possession, to the praise of His glory. **You were sealed** is the aorist passive indicative form of the verb (**sphragidzw**), which means "stamped with a seal."

In the ancient world, the seal was a guarantee or a transaction, e.g., a signet impression on a ring. Sealing was used to authenticate contracts, laws, invoices, military orders. The seal was also used in the ratification of treaties.

Seals were used to preserve tombs, libraries, treasuries. The seal was backed up by the force of the government in charge, e.g., the seal on the tomb of Christ was guaranteed by the Roman troops.

Seals indicate ownership; God owns the believer, having purchased him from the slave market of sin (Eph. 1:7; 1 Cor. 6:20)

The believer is sealed as a guarantee of his eternal security.

### **THE FILLING OF THE HOLY SPIRIT**

When a person accepts Christ as Savior, the Holy Spirit comes into (indwells) his life permanently. The Holy Spirit indwells **for the purpose of glorifying Christ. (Not glorifying Ethiopia)**

Indwelling alone does not guarantee that Christ will be glorified by the believer's life. For this reason, Christians are commanded to be habitually "filled" with the Holy Spirit.

Eph. 5:18, And do not get drunk with wine, for that is dissipation, but be filled with the Spirit,

To conclude my point when any man or woman who believes in gospel message, which is believing in Jesus and His way of salvation, he/she will be a sanctuary of the Holy Spirit.

Baptism is another thing, which a believers experience after knowing about it.

Holy Spirit is as it is clearly stated in the bible...

### **THE HOLY SPIRIT REVEALS DIVINE TRUTH**

1 Cor. 2:9-11, but just as it is written, "Things which eye has not seen and ear has not heard, And which have not entered the heart of man, All that God has prepared for those who love Him."

For to us (believers) God revealed them through the Spirit; for the Spirit searches all things, even the depths of God.

For who among men knows the thoughts of a man except the spirit of the man, which is in him? Even so the thoughts of God no one knows except the Spirit of God.

See also 2 Sam. 23:2; Micah 3:8; Acts 1:16; Heb. 9:6-8; 2 Pet. 1:15-21; John 16:12-14.

### **THE HOLY SPIRIT GLORIFIES THE LORD JESUS CHRIST DURING THE CHURCH AGE**

After the Lord Jesus had ascended to Heaven; the Holy Spirit came to indwell all believers during the Church Age.

John 7:38,39, "He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his innermost being shall flow rivers of living water.'"

But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

The purpose of the indwelling Holy Spirit is *not* to glorify the Holy spirit, but to glorify Christ while He is absent from the earth.

John 16:13,14, "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all

the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

"He shall glorify Me; for He shall take of Mine, and shall disclose it to you.

The believer's body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, and this glorification occurs on the inside of the believer.

1 Cor. 6:19,20 Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you have been bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body.

When a Christian is filled with the Holy Spirit (walking in fellowship), his life is written by the Holy Spirit. He is declared to be the epistles of Christ written by the Holy spirit.

2 Cor. 3:2-6 You are our letter, written in our hearts, known and read by all men; being manifested that you are a letter of Christ, cared for by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone, but on tablets of human hearts. And such confidence we have through Christ toward God. Not that we are adequate in ourselves to consider anything as coming from ourselves, but our adequacy is from God, who also made us adequate as servants of a new covenant, not of the letter, but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.

When a Christian is filled with the Holy Spirit, Christ is at home in the body.

Eph. 3:16,17 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man; so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; and that you, being rooted and grounded in love.

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. [If we initiate to engage ourselves in a dialogue pertaining to such infinite matter in question, as you seem to be wanting to pursue, it would mean to start all over again the whole process of the course of action that brought us to the stage where we are todote: The objective already achieved by the Facts and Messages conveyed through those books and publications aforementioned.](#)

Why should I want to pursue? Just to reach to the truth. You mentioned, you came all the way to the fact, to what you teach today. But I believe you have founded your fact in some bizarre idea. Therefore my question is on what truth did you build? What is your platform? (Since there is only one truth.)

Is the building you build on Christ and His teaching or what...? According to my belief anything against Jesus and His teaching is from evil. I think we should put

much emphasis on the message of the bible 1 Tim 4:1-2

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The Bible is only a small drop of the account that relates about the Truth of God told and recorded by few faithful. It does not cover even the whole thing that pertains to humans, let alone the one that is ascribed to God. The testimony of this truth is asserted in the Gospel of John 21/25 that reads: "**And there are also many other things that Jesus did, which if they were written one by one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that would be written.**"

You may be right that God is not only what the bible mentioned. But don't you think it is enough for our salvation and to know who Jesus is. Let me add the quote you overpass; **John 20:30-31** "Now Jesus performed many other miraculous signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not recorded in this book.; **31** But these are recorded so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name"

2 Tim. 3:15 "Everything in the scripture has been divinely inspired, and it has its uses; to instruct us, to expose our errors, to correct our faults, to educate in holy living"

Psalms 19:7 "The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the **simple**." Why did you need tradition in addition to the Word of God?

Psalms 119:130 "The entrance of thy words giveth light; it giveth understanding unto the **simple**."

Since God expects men and women of all ages to hear, or read, His Word and understand its plain language, then we should expect that God would take great care to protect His Word from contamination or misinterpretation. Indeed, God did take steps to prevent this kind of corruption. Consider the Scriptures below:

"Ye shall not **add** unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye **diminish ought** [take away] from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the LORD your God ..." [Deuteronomy 4:2]

"What thing soever I command you, observe to do it: thou shalt not add thereto, nor diminish from it." [Deuteronomy 12:32]

"Every word of God is pure ... **Add** thou **not** unto his words, lest he reprove thee, and thou be found a liar." [Proverbs 30:5-6] Notice here that anyone who adds to or takes away from God's pure Word is called a "liar".

"For I testify unto every man that heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall **add** unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book: And if any man shall **take away from the words** of the

book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the book of life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book." [Revelation 22:18-19]

Therefore, we can see three distinct warnings against adding to or taking away the Words of God from His Holy Bible. The Pharisees and Sadducees of Jesus' day were the leaders of a religious system which was called The **Traditions of the Elders**, a system which Jesus attacked with all His might, and condemned to the highest degree. In this **Tradition of the Elders**, the priests and scribes had created a parallel "Scripture" (*may be the same as you*) to God's Holy Word. Jesus condemned it because it changed, perverted the true meaning of God's Word, as given to Moses and the Prophets. Listen to Jesus condemn this **Traditions of the Elders. Don't you think that Jesus would condemn the same "parallel scriptures" that is not in his teaching, the bible, or anything against it, in our time.**

"Why do ye also transgress the commandment of God by your tradition? ... Thus have ye made the commandment of God of **none effect** by your **tradition.**" [Matthew 15:3-6]

"Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the **tradition of the elders**, but eat bread with unwashen hands? He answered and said unto them, Well hath Esaias prophesied of you hypocrites, as it is written, This people honoureth me with their lips, but their heart is far from me. Howbeit in **vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men.** [Mark 7:5-7] Do you see that Jesus said that anyone who observes the Tradition of the Elders, they are worshipping Him in **VAIN**?

Now, listen to Jesus continue with His condemnation of this Tradition:

"For laying aside the commandment of God, ye hold the tradition of men ... and many other such like things ye do. And he said unto them, Full well ye **reject** the commandment of God, that ye **may keep your own tradition.**" Did you get this statement? Jesus is saying that Jews who keep the Tradition of the Elders are, in reality, **rejecting** the commandments of God? This same applies to you.

Now, listen to the Apostle Paul condemn the Traditions of the Jews:

**"Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ."** [Colossians 2:8] Here, we see the Apostle Paul stating that the Tradition of Men spoil the hearer, and lead him or her to the world (Like Ethiopia or Ethiopianhood) not to Jesus Christ.

The Apostle Peter warns his followers along these same lines, as well. Listen:

"Forasmuch as ye know that ye were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers" [1 Peter 1:18] Notice here that Peter calls the Tradition of the Fathers "vain conversation". To be honest your teaching inclined to be "vain conversation" "vain deceit" and philosophy after the tradition of men.

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The Ethiopian Case, likewise, is not treated wholly even fractionally there in the Bible. The Bible is a collection of sacred documents predominantly centered on Jewish people who were originally pagans or gentiles or idol worshippers up until the conversion of Abram to Ethiopianhood with a change of name to Abraham by the Ethiopian MelkiZedeq.

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Why did you think God didn't include the teaching you most propagate, in the bible, if it was as essential as you think? Why not treated wholly even fractionally? I always wonder when people try to teach a new teaching which is not in the bible as if it is the most essential teaching for human being. What is the check and balance for your teaching? Or do you want people just to believe what you say by overriding the bible?

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Please note that the term Ethiopianhood is a designation given to all those who worship the One God in the Holy Trinity. As such, it is equivalent to the title of "The Children of God" as contrasted to "the children of humans" who are prone to succumb to Evil.

Please tell me where you get this word "ETHIOPIANHOOD". Or is it a term you created, or a designation given by you?! I can't find it in the bible and even doesn't give a slight hint about it.

Children of God = Ethiopianhood (Amazing equation) really astounding.

WHAT!!! Ethiopians as Incarnate Bible....Are you serious? Sorry to say, but I think you must be out of your mind.

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So, we give precedence and dominance to what God, in accordance with His Prophetic Word (Jer. 31/31-34; Heb. 8/8-13), inscribed on the human hearts, over and above what is written in manuscripts.

First, what God is saying on these two versus you quoted is, based on the old and the new covenant. The old covenant became obsolete because people were unable to keep it. So the new covenant is established so that believers will not walk like the old covenant people by following the written commandments. Read the whole chapter of (1 John 3) about the new man.

Just to clear your points, tell me where it said about Ethiopian on these two versus. Please be honest and answer my question, how you coincide these verse with Ethiopia, Ethiopians or Ethiopian hood.

Second, how is that, what you say, by claiming it is written in your heart, will override the bible, which is the word of God. How can we certify what you say is from God? What is our assurance your teaching is not from the devil if there is no check and balance?

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Accordingly, The Holy Spirit continues upto now and presently and forever to inspire and guide His True Believers (Ethiopians) to live upto the precepts of the Holy Covenant, and then to reveal and propagate (speak and write) the Divine Truth, Mysteries and Deeds, about Ethiopia Who was finally personified by The Virgin Mary, The Mother of God.

If you can not substantiate this claim from the bible, then it is like what the bible said in 2 Peter 2:1-22.

If you claim to be a Christian, you simply have to demonstrate to yourself and to God as well as to your fellow humans, **through your Faith and your Deed**, that you qualify for such status. That is all what you need to do to prove the truthfulness and genuineness of your claim. You do not need to quote verses from the Bible in order to verify who you are. Is it not so?

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The first paragraph was about a believer. Anybody who claims to have this salvation faith, as the bible says, must show it in deeds. It is like saying an orange tree's fruit will be orange fruit. Any body can say this tree is an orange tree when it sees the fruit. In the same manner a believer must walk as children of God to be claimed by men that he is a Christian, but for God as you and I agree He doesn't have to see our deeds to confirm, if we are indeed as we are supposedly claiming, because He can see the heart. In addition according to bible in John 1:12 "But to all who have received him – those who believe in his name<sup>1</sup> – he has given the

right to become God's children [Isa 56:5](#); [Rom 8:15](#); [Gal 3:26](#); [2Pet 1:4](#); [1John 3:1](#);  
**13** – children not born by human parents or by human desire or a husband's decision, but by God." Can you please give emphasis to this word of God for a little while, especially the underlined?

Now my point is, what is the relationship between the believer and Ethiopian regarding a saved man. Yes it is true you can tell somebody that he is an Ethiopian by his language by his color or facial signs, but this is true to any nationals. My point is why is Ethiopia and Ethiopian to do with the bible, salvation, Mary and Jesus. To say clearly this is against what the bible says? And if it is against what the bible says, it is a devil teaching.

Who mentioned about Mary, the mother of Jesus first? It is the Bible, isn't it? Why not the bible mentioned that she is Ethiopian or let me use your expression "The personification of Ethiopia"? Why not? According to your teaching Ethiopia and Ethiopianhood are the main THEME of your teaching, while according to the word of God the main theme is His Kingdom which will be established by Jesus. Why changing His kingdom to Ethiopianhood? Do you examine your teaching, incase a devil puts these teaching in your heart?

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Let me pose, in this regard, one relevant subject matter for your serious consideration that concerns you directly as a Christian let alone as an Ethiopian: Are you aware of the reality that humanity in general and the Christendom (Churches comprising the clergy and the laity, including you) in particular currently strive to serve two masters: two kingdoms (governments), of God and of humans, of Christ and of the devil simultaneously in diametrical contradiction of the guideline ordained by God? ([Mtt. 6/24](#))

What did you mean when you quote Mt 6:24? Jesus is saying that you can't have two Lords, Money and God. He is saying as a believer, God should be your only priority. Let me take this quote and ask you? Is God your priority or Ethiopia which you dream to be a king one day, which I think you believe the throne of Haile silassie belongs to you?

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Just to give you a hint about the issue in discussion: Try to perceive and understand positively the Word that Our Lord Jesus Christ uttered when He responded to the same question you are currently presenting. Here is the Divine Word: **Now, when He [Jesus Christ] was asked by the Pharesees when the Kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, "The Kingdom of God does not come with observation, nor will they say, 'See Here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, The Kingdom of God is within you!"** ([Lk. 17/20-21](#))

Hence, the Fellowship of those individual True Ethiopians of The Holy Covenant who believe that The Kingdom of God is within each one of them constitutes **Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God.**

Are you serious about this? Can't you see anything beside Ethiopia? Just for curiosity case when did you start to exchange the kingdom of God to Ethiopia? Will anybody will be wondered if a Chinese or an Indian or any other national with the same mind like you, rise up and teach by substituting God's kingdom to

Chinese, Indians or other nations? By reading your article one can infer that; Jesus said if an Ethiopian have belief (*Did I insert this word "Believe" which you didn't mention about Jesus intent*) the kingdom is within him, that means that Ethiopian believer is part of the kingdom of God. Which you call the Ethiopian kingdom. Now let's use this for a Chinese, if a Chinese man have faith in God, we use the same conclusion as above that, the kingdom of God will be within him. Now, I want to hear from you is what the fate of this Chinese will be. Did his citizenship changed from Chinese to Ethiopian. Or only Ethiopian will be the one in the kingdom of God? The rest as you said antichrist or anti Jesus as you labeled them.

2 Timothy 4:3,4 "For **the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and they will turn their ears away from the truth** , and be turned aside to fables."

Matthew 15:9 "And **in vain they worship Me, Teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.**"

2 Peter 3:16,17 "as also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things, in which are some things hard to understand, which **untaught and unstable people twist to their own destruction**, as they do also the rest of the Scriptures. You therefore, beloved, since you know this beforehand, **beware lest you also fall from your own steadfastness, being led away with the error of the wicked;**"

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Who are these people whom you refer to as Bible Scholars? Do you really mean these people to be the learned, the scribes and the doctors of the books who misused, misconstrued and misrepresented the True Word of God, especially that relates to Ethiopia and The Ethiopians? You seem to accept and follow their interpretations and attempt to convince us to accept their manipulations.

Just take the verses you yourself quoted concerning Ethiopia and the Ethiopians for example: Ps 68:31 and Amos 9:7. Is the interpretation you gave the proper one that a True Ethiopian renders to these biblical verses? Isn't the latter verse, even as it stands in the versions other than the authentic Ge'ez one, quite explicit in revealing and conveying the True Message that God recognized, loved and preferred the Children of Ethiopia well before and above the Children of Israel? In fact and more importantly, I do not think you realized the reality that the Ge'ez verse does not present the Divine Message in interrogative term as all other versions do, but rather in the positive and affirmative statement.

Just for the sake of argument let me accept that the scholars for such any fancy reason you believe, misuse or misconstrued the true Word of God, especially quotes related to Ethiopia. Let me ask you one thing; is Geez the first language the Old Testament written. I hope you and agree on this that it is written in Hebrew. Then why don't you refer to check this Amos 9:7 chapter in the original language. You will see that it is in interrogative term. But it is clear that the expectant reply is affirmative. The point is how is His insight be the same as

Ethiopians to Israel? And again let me agree with you on this and say it is in the affirmative statement, but please check again what meaning it give, to understand it in context. Please read it on open heart.

**7** **“You Israelites are just like the Ethiopians in my sight,”** says the LORD.

“Certainly I brought Israel up from the land of Egypt,

**but I also brought the Philistines from Caphtor and the Arameans from Kir.**

**8** Look, the sovereign LORD **is watching the sinful nation,**

and I will destroy it from the face of the earth.

But I will not completely destroy the family of Jacob,” says the LORD.

**In context we see that,** None can escape the coming judgment in any hiding-place: for God is omnipresent and irresistible (*Amos 9:1-6*). As a kingdom, Israel shall perish as if it never was in covenant with Him: but as individuals the house of Jacob shall not utterly perish, nay, not one of the least of the righteous shall fall, but only all the sinners (*Amos 9:7-10*). Restoration of the Jews finally to their own land after the re-establishment of the fallen tabernacle of David; consequent conversion of all the heathen (*Amos 9:11-15*).

Having saying that, when we look at two versus of Amos 9:7-8, we see that...

Israel had no reason to think they should be delivered because they were the children of Israel, of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; since they were no more to God than the children of the Ethiopians, having behaved like them; and so accustomed to sin, and hardened in it, that they could no more change their course and custom of sinning.

God is omniscient, and his eyes are everywhere, and upon all persons, good and bad, and upon all kingdoms, especially upon a sinful nation: "the sinning kingdom", or "the kingdom of sin", as it may be rendered; that is addicted to sin, where it prevails and reigns; every such kingdom, particularly the kingdom of Israel, Ephraim, or the ten tribes, given to idolatry, and other sins complained of in this prophecy; and that not for good, but for evil, as in (*Amos 9:4*) ; in order to cut them off from being a people: **and I will destroy it from off the face of the earth:** so that it shall be no more, at least as a kingdom; as the ten tribes have never been since their captivity by Shalmaneser; though Japhet interprets this of all the kingdoms of the earth, being sinful, the eyes of God are upon them to destroy them, excepting the kingdom of Israel; so Abarbinel: **saving that I will not utterly destroy the house of Jacob, saith the Lord;** and so it is, that though they have been destroyed as a kingdom, yet not utterly as a people; there were some of the ten tribes that mixed with the Jews, and others that were scattered about in the world; and a remnant among them, according to the election of grace, that were met with in the ministry of the apostles, and in the latter day all Israel shall be saved;

Just to summarize and get the idea of Amos 9:1-8

Who is God talking to?.....To Israel.

What is God saying?

however great you seem *to yourselves*. Do not rely on past privileges, and on My having delivered you from Egypt, as if therefore I never would remove you from Canaan. I make no more account of you than of "the Ethiopian" (compare Jeremiah 13:23). "Have not I (who) brought you out of Egypt," done as much for other peoples? For instance, did I not bring "the Philistines from Caphtor (compare Deuteronomy 2:23; Syrians from Kir?"

The "Ethiopians," *Hebrew*, "Cushites," were originally akin to the race that founded Babylon: the cuneiform inscriptions in this confirming independently the Scripture statement (Genesis 10:6,8,10).

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The distinctive feature and name presented to humans to make their own individual preference in the eyes of God is one and only one: and that is either to be "Children of God" or "Children of men". Unfortunately, it is proved beyond any doubt that the former are the Ethiopians, represented by The Virgin Mary, and the latter are the rest of humanity: the anti-God, the anti-Christ including the Jews.

For me, even if I am an Ethiopian and loved my country and still living in the land, in spite of having the opportunity to live abroad; it is hard to accept that **any** Ethiopian is a Children of God, and beside Ethiopian, the rest are anti-Christ.

Let us not misuse or distort the Word of God.

John 3:16 "For this is the way **God loved the world**: He gave his one and only Son, so that **everyone who believes in him** will not perish but have eternal life"

1 John 4:9 "By this the love of God is revealed in us: that God has sent his one and only Son **into the world** so that we may live through him"

Luke 19:10 "For the Son of Man **came to seek and to save the lost.**"

Did you have these quotes in your bible or have distorted to give a meaning that Jesus came to seek Ethiopians only.

But my bible says that...

Ga 3:26 "For in Christ Jesus **you are all** sons of God through faith" not only Ethiopian,

but anybody who believes in Jesus according to what the bible teaches.

and the bible continues by saying...

Ga 4:6 "And because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, who calls *Abba!* Father!"

**Oh! I like this very simple gospel.**

**First I have to believe and recive Jesus Christ in my heart(Jn 1:12) and then I will be born again (Jn 3:3-16) then because I am son (not Ethiopian) the Holy Spirit will dwell in me. (Ga 4:6). Please no parallel teaching (MYTH)**

You know what, look below how distortions will be like, and based on your teaching regarding the above quotes, any body can surely say you want to depict the above verses as follows...

John 3:16 "For this is the way God loved **Ethiopia**: He gave his one and only Son, so that **Ethiopian** who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life"

John 1:12 "But to **Ethiopian** who have received him – **Ethiopians** who believe in his name<sup>1</sup> – he has given the right to become **Ethiopian hood.**"

In order for you to be knowledgeable of all these issues, I urge you again to read our books and publications posted on our website, including the recently published one entitled, "ምሥራች! ከእናት ኢትዮጵያ! ለኢትዮጵያ ልጆች! ስለኢትዮጵያዊነት!" or "Good Tidings! From Mother Ethiopia! To The Children Ethiopian! About Ethiopianhood!". All the detailed and analytical explanation of the aforementioned is contained therein.

I don't think any body will be knowledgeable if articles are based on...

- according to the wrighters' desire
- Teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.
- untaught and unstable people twist to their own destruction
- fables
- profane and old wives' fables

If the books you want me to read are against the word of God or override the bible or parallel scripture then as a Christian it is hard to read it, if I am going to take it as a spiritual food.

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I hope the next email that I may receive from you, if any, will emerge only after your perusal of the whole relevant materials referred to in the foregoing paragraphs.

For anybody, with good judgment, to agree with you, first there should be consensus in the word of God, which is the bible. If there is consent then the second step will be to read additional books that do not disagree with the word of God (Bible). However as I can see you are too far from the truth or bible, so how

can you expect me to read all your books. All in all we can say your teaching falls into a MYTH category.

I am an honest person and have no fear to admit a mistake, if anybody comes with supportive points from the bible regarding spiritual teaching.

As I read your last sentence, I think you are not expecting a reply. But here is my reply; I have tried to shorten it as much as I can.

Will I get a reply from you? If you don't have an ego and if you are only for the truth then **YES**, but if there is an ulterior motive **NO**.

### **Our Response to the Third Email from S.GirmaTzion:-**

I still insist that you need very much to read all my books and materials published on our website, for your own good and benefit, since the Messages they convey all concern The Divine Truth. I say this because, had you done so following my recommendation, you wouldn't have bothered that much in exhausting yourself and expending, not only your time and energy but also mine, by writing such a long letter of response with excessive numbers of biblical quotations. That someone could even be the evil man himself from whose ego the evil emanated or one who is possessed by the Devil.

Let me cite, as an example, a case in point in this regard that you raised in your mail: Your allegation that I, to quote from your own statement, "*dream to be a king of Ethiopia one day, which I think you believe the throne of Haile silassie belongs to you.*" Do you realize your delusion, and how you managed to imagine a fabrication of such magnitude? With such mental attitude and actual act, you exposed your real self as one who is:

- ambitious, materialist and secular minded disposed to the lust of temporal power, honour and possession;

- a member of those ethnocentric internal and external groups who attempt to destroy, through disintegration, the unity and integrity that God established for humanity in the name of Ethiopia, initially in Adam and Eve upto the generation of Noah, and in the course of time restored in the Ethiopian MelkiZedeq, and finally in the Ethiopian Jesus Christ, the Incarnate God born of Ethiopia, The Virgin Mary;

- anti-Ethiopia and anti-Christ in the deep sense of the meaning of the words.

As such, you cannot claim to be an Ethiopian, in the true sense and interpretation of the term. You and your likes, disguised in various Christian names, are simply unable to swallow this Truth –The Divine Truth about Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood. How can you prejudge another person before you are sure you really know enough and read about that person and his deeds?

You seem to be someone who is either brainwashed and indoctrinated by any of the anti-Ethiopian peoples: Jews, ecumenical Christian Churches and Denominations, including the Orthodox, the Catholic and the Protestant, or those who hate even the Name of Ethiopia and all what is Ethiopian let alone learn about them. Why do they, including you and your likes, hate Ethiopia and everything that is related to Ethiopia?

The answer to this question is simple: It is because Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood preceded all of them in coming to existence, and continue their existence to this day and forever in freedom despite all hostilities perpetrated by their adversaries. The existence of Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood happened even long before the compilation of the Bible itself, and long before the individual formation of the above mentioned bodies took place as entities so as to gain recognition in the Bible.

Would'nt it be an act of prudence on your part to heed to my earlier advice before you give such hasty judgment on me and my works, on one who is wholly absorbed in the Service of the Divine Truth of Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God? It is pointed out in the preambles of those publications that one has to be inspired and guided by the Holy Spirit just to pick up and read one of them in which the Messages of the Divine Truth are contained. Would your reluctance and fear to read them be considered as a sign of that notion being applicable to your case? Otherwise, it would be difficult to speculate the cause that hinders you from doing so?

You also seem to be completely ignorant about the mission we are engaged in and committed to. The cornerstone of our existence and vocation is THE DIVINE TRUTH, and nothing else, but THE DIVINE TRUTH. Our sole commission is founded and focussed only on The Divine Truth that was finally and eternally revealed two milleniums ago in the person of Jesus Christ, Son of God and The Virgin Mary. But this same Divine Truth remained stifled and perverted, misused and manipulated to this day by the so-called Christian Churches in particular and by humanity in general.. I hope and pray that the Holy Spirit, this time, will bring you to your senses, and give you the strength to control your emotions and the inspiration that would lead you to reading His Messages conveyed through those books referred above.

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#### **Fourth Email from S. GirmaTSION:-**

I thought I have explained enough about my intention. I ask you a simple question. But it seems that you don't have a simple answer except forwarding me again to read your book. As I stated in my last email...

As such, you cannot claim to be an Ethiopian, in the true sense and interpretation of the term. You and your likes, disguised in various Christian names, are simply unable to swallow this Truth -The Divine Truth about Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood. Look,

you even refused and remained obstinate to know The Divine Truth about the latter by rejecting our invitation to read the materials that are meant just for this purpose.

No comment on this as I have replied above. Just to add a point, don't say OUR invitation, just say MY invitation, since you are the only one I heard propagating this peculiar teaching.

Where is your biblical faith and knowledge let alone your piety if you are incapable to discern the Divine Truth that Ethiopians, male and female, without distinction, who believe and live up to the precepts of all the seven Holy Covenants enshrined in the Bible that culminated in The Holy Virgin Mary and Her Son Jesus Christ, are all, True Sons and Daughters of God according to the Gospel of John 1/12-13, and as such, Kings and Queens in the Kingdom of God, according to Rev. 20/4-6.

As I have replied regarding this thinking, in my last email, I don't want to waste your time and my time. But I just want to remind you by quoting two verses from my previous email...

**Ga 3:28** "There is neither Jew nor Greek, slave nor free, male nor female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus."

I wish I know how you understand this.

**Jn 1:12-13** "But as many as received him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his Name, Which were borne, **not of blood**, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God"

I don't think you need the blood of Ethiopian race to be a son. To be a son irrespective of race blood or gender, what is needed is to receive the Son of God.

You seem to be someone who is either brainwashed and indoctrinated by any of the anti-Ethiopian peoples: Jews, ecumenical Christian Churches and Denominations, including the Orthodox, the Catholic and the Protestant, or those who hate even the Name of Ethiopia and all what is Ethiopian let alone learn about them. Why do they, including you and your likes, hate Ethiopia and everything that is related to Ethiopia?

Yes I am brainwashed by the word of God. Don't you think it is better than following mens' teaching? You see what I understand is if you are a believer you are son's of God. In God's kingdom there is no Jew, Greek (gentile)(Ethiopian), slave free or royal family, male or female. (**Gal 3:28**)

**Eph 4:14** "So we are no longer to be children, tossed back and forth by waves and carried about by **every wind of teaching by the trickery of people** who craftily carry out **their deceitful schemes**"

Do you know what God said in His words about teaching that will come out in the last days...?

**1 Tim 4:1** “Now **the Spirit explicitly says** that in **the later times** some **will desert the faith** and **occupy themselves** with **deceiving spirits and demonic teachings**”

**2 Tim 4:3-4** “For **there will be a time** when people **will not tolerate sound teaching**. Instead, **following their own desires**, they will accumulate teachers for themselves, because they have **an insatiable curiosity to hear new things**. And they will **turn away from hearing the truth**, but on the other hand **they will turn aside to myths**.”

Did you hear what God is saying?

The existence of Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood happened even long before the compilation of the Bible itself, and long before the individual formation of the above mentioned bodies took place as entities so as to gain recognition in the Bible.

Please can you tell me where you get this? Do you have any supporting document? Or do you want me to believe this, because you said so.

**Gal 1:6-9** “I am astonished that you are so quickly deserting the one who called you by the grace of Christ and are **following a different gospel** – not that there really is another gospel, but there are some who are disturbing you and wanting **to distort the gospel of Christ**. But even **if we (or an angel from heaven)** should preach a gospel contrary to the one we preached to you, let him be condemned to hell! As we have said before, and now I say again, **if anyone is preaching to you a gospel contrary to what you received, let him be condemned to hell!**”

**2 Cor 11:4** “**For if someone comes and proclaims another Jesus different from the one we proclaimed**, or if you receive a different spirit than the one you received, or a different gospel than the one you accepted, you put up with it well enough!”

Did Apostle Paul said another Jesus? Perhaps did he mean like the Ethiopian Jesus you mentioned?

Let me remind you that the name or word of Ethiopia is not the significant factor: Any other name could be given or applied. What is significant is the ideal of The Divine Truth that is carried by the name or the word. And this fact is concisely expressed in the Ethiopian Creed and Testimonial of the Holy Covenant, Glorification of The Lord and Exultation of The Virgin Mary written on four pages. Read them in our publications and in the FAITH forum of our website! The name or word Ethiopian is synonymous with designations like Ag'azian, Am'hara and/or Christian which all connote attainment of "Divine Freedom". The name Ethiopia was preferred simply because of its precedence over the aforementioned, and over all the other names on earth, including Paganism, Judaism, and Christianity, let alone the comparatively recent terms like Orthodoxy, Catholicism and Protesntantism.

Are you the one who wrote this paragraph? Did I read that “The name or word of Ethiopia not the significant factor”?

In all your replies I haven't read a statement that leads me to read a quotation from the bible to support your idea just like I did. Incredible!! You just wanted me to read your teaching which I regard it as "a gospel contrary to the word of God or that follows your own desire not God's."

Why are you so reluctant or scared to read the materials, i.e., the books and publications, referred to you about Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood? Wouldn't it be an act of prudence on your part to heed to my earlier advice before you give such hasty judgment on me and my works, on one who is wholly absorbed in the Service of the Divine Truth of Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God? It is pointed out in the preambles of those publications that one has to be inspired and guided by the Holy Spirit just to pick up and read one of them in which the Messages of the Divine Truth are contained. Would your reluctance and fear to read them be considered as a sign of that notion being applicable to your case? Otherwise, it would be difficult to speculate the cause that hinders you from doing so.

As I made myself clear in my previous email and in this, if we you have replied my simple answer that I asked and agree with and substantiate it from the bible, then it will be easy for me to read your books.

Let me ask you a question, will you go to a witch just because someone said, before you make any judgments first go and learn or experience what they do and then you will say that it is from God or from the Devil? Will you do that? I don't think so! The first thing you will do is, even if you don't want to be biased by what you have heard, ask if they do follow the word of God, or who is their Lord, or what their teachings are or if what they do is according what the bible says? Isn't it? This applies the same with me. It is not reluctance or fear.

**2 Tim 1:7** "For God did not give us a Spirit of **fear** but of power and love and self-control."

Again, you seem to be bewildered by those issues that remain mysterious and secretive by the abusers of The Divine Truth and that we raised openly based on the true presentation of The Divine Truth. I don't know how you pray, but do you think that Holy Spirit will lead me to read a book contrary to the Bible, which he authored. Who leads anybody to read what is against the work of God? You answer it.

Let me finish my point by saying this.

First I admire you for taking your time to answer my reply; thank you for this.

What I am asking you again is reply the first question I asked with supportive quotes from the bible. It is that simple!! If you cannot answer, then it is difficult to agree with and even continue reading your books.

My last paragraph will be the same as you wrote and also with earnest heart.

I hope and pray that the Holy Spirit, this time, will bring you to your senses, and give you the strength to control your emotions and the inspiration that would lead you to reading His Messages conveyed through **the word of God, the Bible** and remain in the teaching of Christ. Also to help you abstinate to read and teach what is against or that overrides the word of God, the bible.

2 Jn 1:9 "Everyone who **goes on ahead and does not remain in the teaching of Christ does not have God**. The one who remains in this teaching has both the Father and the Son."

Hope to hear from you with explanation from the sound doctrine taught by the bible. And dare to quote and use bible verses when you proclaim anything you want to pass instead of saying Mine, My booking etc.

## **Our Response to the Fourth Email from S. GirmaTSION:-**

Let me give you, on behalf of Our Services, the following brief comments on some of the relevant and important points of common interest raised in your email that deserve proper treatment:

1. First of all, please be informed of the fact that whenever I say "we", "our" and/or "us" in my current and earlier correspondences with you as well as with others elsewhere, I am referring to the multitude of True Ethiopians of The Holy Covenant, residing inside and outside of Ethiopia. These are presently in fellowship with me in Faith and Deed, Life and Service. Their names, numbers and whereabouts are known and inscribed in The Divine Book of Eternal Life only by The Holy Spirit. These Elects, while I know and work with some personally, you are not qualified and capable to know their person and name, their numbers and whereabouts.

I am obliged to say this in refutation to your remark that reads: *"Don't say OUR invitation, just say MY invitation, since you are the only one I heard propagating this peculiar teaching."*

Even if you seem to be obsessed simply in quoting verses from the Bible without the will to properly understand and implement them, I still suggest to you to consult the following relevant Words of God in the Bible. They are cited herein, in reference to your criticism of my being alone in the current crusade I am committed to and your disregard to the countless number of the Faithfull Ethiopians with whom I am in fellowship through the Holy Spirit: 1 Ki. 19/10-18, Rom. 11/ 2-5 as well as Matt. 26/56.

From these quotations, you may be able to visualize the response Prophet Elijah received from God, and the situation where and when Our Lord Jesus Christ was left alone, abandoned even by His close Disciples. Finally, you will be in a better position to make your own conclusion out of your assessment of my case against your remark noted above.

2. After my last email response, I thought you and I would come to terms of understanding and settle our divergent positions in harmony, at least for the time being, by giving, on your part, precedence to my suggestion that invites you to primarily resort to reading those books that convey the Messages of The Divine Truth about Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God, **all based solely on the quotations and references of the Bible.**

But that did not turn out to be the case, as seen and acted upon from your perspective. I discern that you are bent to draw me into an engagement of polemics which I reject outright and which is also biblically proscribed. However, as the issue we are discussing relates to the Holy Spirit, such Divine Issue does not require of us this sort of conducting our task. The guiding principle and commitment of Our Service to Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God, inspired exclusively by the Holy Spirit, is only the dissemination of the Knowledge of God to those who are interested in It, and search for It.

Yes, **our sole objective is to enlighten and teach those who want to know and learn about The Divine Truth that concerns Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God.** This is exactly the kind of service that I offered you from the beginning and in line with our standing principle which continued throughout my current correspondence with you.

3. Our position and status being such, you do not deny the fact that **we are not, but you who approached us and initiated this correspondence.** If such is the case, why did you approach us and initiated this

correspondence with us in the first place? We thought it was with good and genuine intention that you wrote your first email to us. When we received it, we honestly believed that your singular purpose was **to learn and know about Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God**, as it is openly and expressly publicised on our website. We responded to your request and need accordingly and appropriately. We did not expect that you had an ulterior motive: A confrontational one that surfaced in the short run.

Then, how on earth would you characterize such approach of yours to us and our response to you as *"going to a witch just because someone said, before you make any judgments first go and learn or experience what they do and then you will say that it is from God or from the Devil."*, to cite from your own words. Even if you did it initially without knowing about our Services and before reaching at your subsequent conclusion, why did you continue corresponding with us after you knew about the same under such circumstance? You should have stopped it at least after our first response.

**I urge you to do just that even now**, if you do not accept my recommendation to you to give priority to your own enlightenment with regard to Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, The Kingdom of God primarily by resorting to reading those books and publications already referred to. Yes, you need **to stop writing to us** if you persist in your present intransigence.

4. How much more can I be explicit and simplify my reply to your first question that you reiterated again and again: Your question to be presented with supportive quotes from the Bible regarding the subject matter of Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God.

The answer to your question was repeatedly given in my previous emails. In one of my emails it reads: "Surprisingly, since we, on our part, never use in our writings, as reference, any other book except the Holy Bible, almost all your biblical quotations and commentaries (contained in your emails) are compiled in those aforementioned books and publications of mine, of course, in their proper context and interpretations."

5. Here, don't forget that your interpretation of the Word of God in the Bible might differ from that of ours, in the same way that had occurred for centuries on end among all the different Churches and their denominations across the world.

In our case of the interpretation of the Word of God in the Bible, **we, as Ethiopians of the Holy Covenant, rely entirely on the Divine**

**Law of Truth that God The Holy Spirit inscribed on our individual hearts of wholeness,** and not on what is written on material objects. This established position of Ethiopians of the Holy Covenant is maintained in accordance with The Divine Promise ordained in Jeremiah 31/31-34; Jn. 6/45, 14/25 and Acts. 1/8 that was finally fulfilled in Acts. 2/1-4, 2Cor. 3/3-18 and Heb. 8/8-13.

Hence, all those so-called "Words of God" created, added and written by humans, together with their interpretations given by the same, that do not comply with the **the Divine Law of Truth that God The Holy Spirit inscribed on our individual hearts of wholeness** are rendered null and void. This pronouncement of the Ethiopians of the Holy Covenant is vindicated by one of the epitomes from the above biblical quotations that reads: **"God... made us sufficient as ministers of the New Covenant, not of the letter, but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but The Spirit gives Life."**

6. Notwithstanding the points raised in the foregoing, you still seem to ask me to rewrite in my email response all those details and analysis I put up extensively in those books and publications. But, here, you ought to comprehend and consider the enormity of your request: To explain in a manner stated above with supporting verses from the Bible in reference to cases of Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God is not something that is easy and simple as you imagine.

The issue of Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God is one that had been singled out to be dominated and overwhelmed by anti-Ethiopian alien forces throughout the last seven milleniums, more significantly by some adverse influences of Judaism 3000 years ago and of Egyptian (Coptic) Orthodoxy 1,600 years ago, and relatively in recent times, by those of Westerners' Catholicism, Protestantism and Democratic Liberalism as well as by Easterners' Communism, Paganism and Jihadism.

In the long run, the age-old effect of these overwhelming dominations and influences of the adversaries of Ethiopia was so severe and powerfull that the same became deeply entrenched and malignant on the hearts and minds of the majority of so-called Ethiopians. Since then, the case of Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God remained, not only neglected and despised, but also completely discarded, and actually considered dead, buried and mentally forgotten by the so-called Ethiopians themselves. And the latter just as well remained victimized and continued to languish for centuries on end and to this day, like yourself, by the sinister

brainwash and indoctrination, perpetrated by those alien forces aforementioned.

So, such reality rendered it, not only difficult, but also insurmountable to alleviate the unfortunate situation from those victims subjected to the same, as you may sufficiently recognize this fact by now from your own negative reaction to and rejection of my suggestion as well as from your intransigent position not to read our books and publications that deal with the subject matter at hand.

This is true to the extent of such endeavour becoming impossible and infeasible to undertake, because even to mention, let alone teach and convince, the question of Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God to the so-called Ethiopians, including those members of the present generation like you, proved unthinkable.

7. In order to resurrect such Heavenly Treasure that had suffered so much wickedness under the yoke of human suppression, domestic and foreign, enduring the same experience of Jesus Christ, and to remind concerned individual members of the present generation of humanity in general and that of Ethiopia in particular like you, I, a mere humble creature unworthy to the calling, needed to put into writing and produce volumes of books, containing only the Divine Messages about Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God, supported by verses quoted solely from the Holy Bible.

Do you want me to undertake now such heavy task once again just to satisfy or for the sake of your personal whim? No, I can't. And why should I be required to do just that, when the best alternative is there ready for you, and presented to you to make use of it immediately: My repeated reference to you to look for and read those books and publications posted on our website.

8. The phenomenon of Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of The Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God, being The Work of God, does not require, for Its execution and permanence, any kind of human methods and facilities, support and intervention, as seen in all Divine Creations.

It is initiated and conducted, pursued and consummated by The Holy Spirit Himself. Humans, like me, through the Inspiration and Guidance of The Holy Spirit write scripts simply to remind and make their fellow human beings like you to know what God had stored for them so that they benefit out of Those Treasures of Divine Knowledge of The Divine Truth.

9. Your positive and categorical statement in which you affirmed that you are brainwashed "*by the word of God*" proved that you are the victim of those alien evil forces that invaded Ethiopia, Ethiopians and everything that is Ethiopian from time immemorial with their sinister objective to destroy Our Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God, and who brag in their current apparent success of subjugating individual members of the present Ethiopian generation like you.

Don't try to demean The Word of God and The Grace of The Holy Spirit as you had done on the dignified creation of yourself in the Image of God. **The Word of God is embeded by the Inspiration of the Holy Spirit alone in the hearts, minds and bodies of Faithful Believers of The Holy Covenant** whose consummate personifications are Jesus Christ Our Lord and His Holy Mother The Virgin Mary.

*Brainwashing and indoctrination* are the devilish tools of manipulation operated by Satan and wicked humans upon other fellow humans of weak disposition like you. To apply such words to "The Word of God", even by implication, is simply sacrilegious. I pity you for making yourself a product of that evil manoeuvre.

Please be reminded that it is The Word of God that became Flesh in Incarnation; and The Incarnate God that ascended to His Heavenly Throne had finally came back to us in The Holy Spirit. It is the ever continuous Inspiration of The Holy Spirit that FREES those Faithful Believers who **"worship God in Truth and Spirit"** from any and/or every kind of physical, mental and spiritual bondage that is conceived of and conducted by humans as well as from that that originates from the Evil Spirit.

And this is THE FREEDOM that Jesus Christ, Our Creator and God, Priest and King spoke about in Jn. 8/32 saying, **"You shall know The Truth, and The Truth shall make you FREE."**

The Truth that FREES us from any bondage is The Divine Truth revealed in the Person of Our Lord Jesus Christ born of The Virgin Mary. And that Truth returned to us and transcendently lives among and within us as **The Spirit of Truth** Who is THE OMNIPRESENT HOLY SPIRIT.

Had you been free from that relentlessly suppressive evil bondage, you wouldn't have acted the way you did so far. This is the FREEDOM that is God-given, and the ONE that we enjoy, through the Inspiration and Guidance of THE SPIRIT OF TRUTH, to explore every domain of Divine Creation and human inventions without any limitation whatsoever. And this is the FREEDOM that *you are reluctant to accept and scared to death to exercise.*

10. If you do not accept your being labeled as someone reluctant and fearsome to read those books and publications that convey the Messages of The Divine Truth of The Holy Covenant based solely on Scriptures, or as someone who is brainwashed and indoctrinated by anti-Ethiopian alien forces, then how are you to be branded or identified with?

Under the circumstances, yes, you ought to be branded as and identified with those Jewish zealots who were after Our Lord Jesus Christ to destroy Him in their hatred and jealousy, accusing Him of blasphemy and innovation of their Law, even though He emphatically declared that **He did not come to destroy the Law or the Prophet, but to fulfil them.** (Matt. 5/17)

As such, you may be considered the image of Saul, the former intransigent Jewish Fanatic who stubbornly refused to listen to the teachings of Our Lord Jesus Christ but rather was determined to engage in persecuting the True Followers of Jesus Christ until he was subdued by the Divine Power of The Holy Spirit to succumb to The Will of God and become the illustrious icon among the Aposles with the new name of Paul.

I hope you, in your current fanatical disposition proving for now to be another Saul, may follow suit and transform yourself by the Divine Power of The Holy Spirit to become one of the present True Ethiopian Pauls who, in the Service of Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God, would be called by and readily accept The Divine Ordination to proclaim the Good Tidings of The Divine Truth about Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant.

As you are skilled in the art of quoting Biblical verses, the reference from one of the Epistles of St. Paul may perhaps convince you to resort to the books and publications that I persistently urged you to read: **“Test all things; hold fast what is good.”** (1Thess. 5/21.)

11. From our email correspondence, one could easily deduce a manifestation of a fundamental lack of understanding between your motive and my service. Such unfortunate situation prevails only because the kind of spirit that dominates and impels you to such degree of intransigence is not compatible with the Holy Spirit that Inspires and Guides our Service of Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God.

Then, what is the spirit that emboldens you to portray such Fruit of the Service of Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God produced by the Inspiration and Guidance of the Divine Truth Who is Himself The Holy Spirit, as “a myth”? The answer to this interrogative statement must be straightforward: It is the Evil Spirit.

And this is a bad omen for you. Your present attitude and behaviour seem to entertain upon yourself a condition that resembles

suicidal self destruction, similar to the fate that had befallen Judas the Iscariot.

The Divine Truth that relates about Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God is not a myth, but a stark REALITY that eternally exists and perpetually works from time immemorial, only to be revealed two milleniums ago in the Incarnate God Jesus Christ born of The Virgin Mary and in the susequent Return of The Holy Spirit for the sake of Creation in general and of humanity in particular.

Hence, until you pay attention to my advice and find out the same Divine Truth from those books and publications referred to you, yes, the stark REALITY of The Divine Truth that relates about Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethipianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God remains and continues **to haunt you as “A MYTH.”**

The myth is your own evil perception that your secular mind created for your own consumption by means of which, in the Word of Our Lord, you are **“cast into outer darkness where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth!”** (Matt. 22/1-14)

12. Based on The Divine Truth and in consideration of all the statements of facts outlined above, much observations and conclusions could be made. However, on my part, I do not want even to think let alone give any personal judgment on the mental attitude you had towards our Services and manifested in your email contents. To pass such judgment is the domain of The Holy Spirit. Only Our Lord Jesus Christ judges us through The Holy Spirit, now and hereafter, pursuant to His Word that says, **“I am coming..., and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work!”** (Rev. 22/12)

I simply admonish you to refrain from such self-destructive attitude and behaviour of persistant refusal and to heed to my recommendation to you **to read those books and articles posted on our website that carry the Messages of the Divine Truth about Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God of The Holy Covenant.**

Otherwise, your continuous impulsive engagement of polemics with our Services would amount to a flagrant confrontation directed against and an act of contempt towards **The Work of The Holy Spirit.** Such conduct of interaction of yours, directed against our Services, in turn, constitutes, in the Word of Our Lord Jesus Christ, **"sin and blasphemy"** and invokes upon yourself the Divine Judgment ordained by Him: **The "sin and blasphemy" thus committed "will not be forgiven either in this age or in the age to come."** (Matt. 12/22-32.)

So, if you feel that you are truly a man of God, I plead with you, even now, to seriously reconsider your position of recalcitrance against

The Holy Spirit and make the appropriate repentance for your own sake and wellbeing.

But now let me turn you, from the purposely done diversion, and ask you something, don't you have a simple answer to a simple question raised? Most of your statements are illusory. I haven't seen any statement backed by correct scripture to support your idea and which properly implemented. You have quoted a few scripture believing they support your idea. I wonder if you have the boldness to write the scripture you quoted and explain to me what it says, instead of quoting the numbers only and say these quotes supports my idea. If you have seen how I quote the verses and write them with boldness because they exactly support what I said.

To illustrate my virtue; Let me quote again one of the verses you quoted and see what it says...

Even if you seem to be obsessed simply in quoting verses from the Bible without the will to properly understand and implement them, I still suggest to you to consult the following relevant Words of God in the Bible. They are cited herein, in reference to your criticism of my being alone in the current crusade I am committed to and your disregard to the countless number of the Faithfull Ethiopians with whom I am in fellowship

through the Holy Spirit: 1 Ki. 19/10-18, Rom. 11/ 2-5 as well as Matt. 26/56.

Let me try to write down one of the quotes and see if your bible and my bible are the same...Rom 11:2-5 + up to 24

*Rom 11:2-24 "God has not rejected his people whom he foreknew! Do you not know what the scripture says about Elijah, how he pleads with God against Israel? **3** "Lord, **they have killed your prophets, they have demolished your altars; I alone am left and they are seeking my life!"** **4** But what was the divine response to him? "**I have kept for myself seven thousand people who have not bent the knee to Baal.**" **5** So in the same way at the present time there is a remnant chosen by grace." **6** And if it is by grace, it is no longer by works, otherwise grace would no longer be grace. **7** What then? Israel failed to obtain what it was diligently seeking, but the elect obtained it. The rest were hardened,**8** as it is written, "**God gave them a spirit of stupor, eyes that would not see and ears that would not hear, to this very day.**" **9** And David says, "**Let their table become a snare and trap, a stumbling block and a retribution for them; **10** let their eyes be darkened so that they may not see, and make their backs bend continually.**"*

***11** I ask then, they did not stumble into an irrevocable fall, did they? Absolutely not! But by their transgression salvation has come to the Gentiles, to make Israel jealous. **12** Now if their transgression means riches for the world and their defeat means riches for the Gentiles, how much more will their full restoration bring? **13** Now I am speaking to you Gentiles. Seeing that I am an apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my ministry, **14** if somehow I could provoke my people to jealousy and save some of them. **15** For if their rejection is the reconciliation of the world, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead? **16** If the first portion of the dough offered is holy, then the whole batch is holy, and if the root is holy, so too are the branches. **17** Now if some of the branches were broken off, and you, a wild olive shoot, were grafted in among them and participated in the richness of the olive root, **18** do not boast over the branches. But if you boast, remember that you do not support the root, but the root supports you. **19** Then you will say, "The branches were broken off so that I could be grafted in." **20** Granted! They were broken off because of their unbelief, but you stand by faith. Do not be arrogant, but fear! **21** For if God did not spare the natural branches, perhaps he will not spare you. **22** Notice therefore the kindness and harshness of God – harshness toward those who have fallen, but God's kindness toward you, provided you continue in his kindness; otherwise you also will be cut off. **23** And even they – if they do not continue in their unbelief – will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again. **24** For if you were cut off from what is by nature a wild olive tree, and grafted, contrary to nature, into a cultivated olive tree, how much more will these natural branches be grafted back into their own olive tree?"*

Now tell me if your bible and mine are the same,

- Who are the Israelis?
- Who are God's people that God has not rejected?

- Who are the remnants chosen?
- What does it mean when it says "So in the same way" or Greek word "οὕτως"
- Who are the gentiles?
- Who are the branches?

Tell me where this eccentric, bizarre Ethiopia and Ethiopianhood ideas are in this chapter?

I know you would say "go and read, all is explained and put in proper place in my books. Why you fear?"

Brother I took this kind of statement as a **stalking-horse**.

Please come out from your shell, and be for once be bold enough to answer, if you really have an answer to the simple question I raised before based on the true word of God, neglecting and avoiding the fables and also leave out your personal assertion.

The simple questions raised were:

- Ethiopia is the kingdom of God. How?
- Mary the mother of Jesus is Ethiopian. How?

I need a simple answer from the bible quoting a verse to support your idea. (*Is it obsession to quote the word of God to support your idea? I took this statement as only feigning.*)

Please, Don't go round the bush.

To make my point clear, I cannot see intransigence or recalcitrance in my part. I accepted Jesus as my personal savior. **Plain and simple!**

The Holy Spirit inhabits in me, just because I accepted Jesus as my savior and I became a son. (Jn 1:12) **No addition please!**

Gal 4:6 "And because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, who calls "Abba! Father!" **No addition please!**

Rom 8:15 "For you did not receive the spirit of slavery leading again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption, by whom we cry, "Abba, Father." **No addition please!**

1 Cor 2:12 "Now we have not received the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, so that we may know the things that are freely given to us by God." **No addition please!**

Gal 3:26 "For in Christ Jesus you are all sons of God through faith" **No addition please!**

**Now let me reply to some of your statements that needs a response from me...**

These Elects, while I know and work with some personally, you are not qualified and capable to know their person and name, their numbers and whereabouts.

Sorry to say, but I don't care and I don't need to know the names and the numbers, because these things shouldn't be one's main goal. Nevertheless, if this claim is to be true, I sympathize for them thinking of their destiny.

*Mat 18:6 "But if anyone causes one of these little ones who believe in me to sin, it would be better for him to have a huge millstone hung around his neck and to be drowned in the open sea."*

*Rom 16:17-18"Now I urge you, brothers and sisters, to watch out **for those who create dissensions and obstacles contrary to the teaching that you learned. Avoid them!** For these are the kind who do not serve our Lord Christ, **but their own appetites.** By their smooth talk and flattery **they deceive the minds of the naive.**"*

*Col 2:8 "Be careful **not to allow anyone to captivate you through an empty, deceitful philosophy that is according to human traditions and the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ.**"*

From these quotations, you may be able to visualize the response Prophet Elijah received from God, and the situation where and when Our Lord Jesus Christ was left alone, abandoned even by His close Disciples. Finally, you will be in a better position to make your own conclusion out of your assessment of my case against your remark noted above.

Hard to understand what you mean when the bible verses you quotes and the association to your statement. **Completely out of tune, and lacking enlightenment of the Word of God!**

*2 Cor 4:3-4 "But even if our gospel is veiled, it is **veiled only to those who are perishing, among whom the god of this age has blinded the minds of those who do not believe so they would not see the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God.**"*

I discern that you are bent to draw me into an engagement of polemics which I reject outright and which is also biblically proscribed.

And this...

How much more can I be explicit and simplify my reply to your first question that you reiterated again and again: Your question to be

presented with supportive quotes from the Bible regarding the subject matter of Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God.

The answer to your question was repeatedly given in my previous emails. In one of my emails it reads: "Surprisingly, since we, on our part, never use in our writings, as reference, any other book except the Holy Bible, almost all your biblical quotations and commentaries (contained in your emails) are compiled in those aforementioned books and publications of mine, of course, in their proper context and interpretations."

I took all these showcases as a **pretension**.

**Our sole objective is to enlighten and teach those who want to know and learn about The Divine Truth that concerns Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God.**

I really and with my full heart believe you don't have a single, I repeat, a single verse to support your conception of alleged "DIVINE TRUTH". This is what you only propagate by distorting the truth and swing them (the least learned of the bible or the unfortunate naives) to their doom.

*1 Tim 4:1" **1** Now the Spirit explicitly says that in the later times some will desert the faith and occupy themselves with deceiving spirits and **demonic teachings,**"*

*Eph 4:14 "So we are no longer to be children, tossed back and forth by waves and carried about by every wind of teaching by the **trickery of people** who craftily carry out **their deceitful schemes.**"*

Again sorry to say, but as the word of God called them, You seem to me a TRICKERY PERSON, unless you prove your teaching by the word of GOD. **Plain and simple!!**

**Just as an addition, don't be dismayed when I quote the word of God, I only quote to support my statement. Only the devil and people under the rule of the darkness don't like when the word of God is quoted.**

Our position and status being such, you do not deny the fact that **we are not, but you who approached us and initiated this correspondence.** If such is the case, why did you approach us and initiated this correspondence with us in the first place?

This one has a truth statement; yes it is me who started the discussion by asking a simple two question believing you have a simple answer. But have got no simple answers up to now, instead I received from you pretension and a load of accusations and charges.

Why did you continue corresponding with us after you knew about the same and under such circumstance? You should have stopped it at least after our first response.

**First** I still continue to seek the truth because there was no answer to my simple questions. **Second** because as the bible say, I am an ambassador of Christ and plead with everyone on Christ's behalf, "Be reconciled to God." I don't have to ignore when I think people are on the wrong way. And also I don't want to quickly recognize them as deceivers; instead I have to know you by discussion and reading your answers on that question I raised which touches your pillar teaching.

*2 Cor 5:16-20 "So then from now on we acknowledge no one from an outward human point of view. Even though we have known Christ from such a human point of view, now we do not know him in that way any longer. **17** So then, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; what is old has passed away – look, what is new has come! **18** And all these things are from God who reconciled us to himself through Christ, and who has given us the ministry of reconciliation. **19** In other words, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting people's trespasses against them, and he has given us the message of reconciliation. **20** Therefore we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were making His plea through us. We plead with you on Christ's behalf, "Be reconciled to God!"*

Hence, all those so-called "Words of God" created, added and written by humans, together with their interpretations given by the same, that do not comply with the the Divine Law of Truth that God The Holy Spirit inscribed on our individual hearts of wholeness are rendered null and void. This pronouncement of the Ethiopians of the Holy Covenant is vindicated by one of the epitomes from the above biblical quotations that reads: "**God... made us sufficient as ministers of the New Covenant, not of the letter, but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but The Spirit gives Life.**"

Please give me **JUST ONE**, only one, to substantiate or solidify your claims. Which I doubt you have one, so this claim seems rhetoric!

Notwithstanding the points raised in the foregoing, you still seem to ask me to rewrite in my email response all those details and analysis I put up

extensively in those books and publications. But, here, you ought to comprehend and consider the enormity of your request: To explain in a manner stated above with supporting verses from the Bible in reference to cases of Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God is not something that is easy and simple as you imagine.

Hard to believe!! As I can answer with no more than two pages for each questions I raised by supporting from the word of God against your claim.

The Kingdom of God is not something that is easy and simple as you imagine.

Well, it's important to recognize that no one fully understands all of the depth and nuances of the riches found in the Bible. The Bible is God's revelation of Himself to mankind, and since God is infinite, the knowledge of Him is also infinite. But the mind of man is finite and is therefore incapable of fully understanding the depth of Truth. (Romans 11:32-34) expresses it thus: "Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable his judgments, and his paths beyond tracing out! "Who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has been his counselor?" God reminds us through the prophet Isaiah: "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts" (Isaiah 55:9).

**That said, however, man is certainly capable of understanding the basic doctrines of the Bible and the knowledge of God which He has made clear to us (Romans 1:19). He has provided in His Word all we need to know for salvation and godly living.** God does not try to confuse us when it comes to any biblical topic, especially salvation; "For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace" (1 Corinthians 14:33 KJV). Likewise, He has made it simple to understand how we are saved. When asked what needed to be done in order to be saved, Paul and Silas made it very clear: "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved – you and your household" (Acts 16:31). In John 6:28-29, Jesus was asked "What must we do to do the works God requires?" to which Jesus answered, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one He has sent." Jesus also said "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies" (John 11:25). The Bible declares that it is faith that saves us, not understanding. But genuine faith will result in more and more understanding of God's Word as we grow in Christ because the Author of Scripture—the Holy Spirit—dwells in our hearts, and He will lead us into all truth (John 16:13). Without Him, we are unable to understand spiritual truth (1 Corinthians 2:14). **So the first requirement for understanding Scripture is a true saving faith in Christ not be Ethiopian.**

The Bible makes it perfectly clear that "all Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the man of God may

be thoroughly equipped for every good work” (2 Timothy 3:16-17). Psalm 119:130 declares that “The unfolding of your words gives light; it gives understanding to the simple.” However, this understanding doesn’t come with periodic skimming through popular Bible verses; it comes with eagerness to study and examine the Scriptures every day as the Bereans (Acts 17:11). Paul said that the Bereans were of more noble character than even the Thessalonians because of the eagerness to search the Scriptures that they exhibited.

All too often, people do not understand the Bible because they are reluctant to accept what it says: “Their ears are hard of hearing, and their eyes they have closed, lest they should see with their eyes and hear with their ears, lest they should understand with their heart and turn, so that I should heal them” (Matthew 13:15 NKJV). Regardless of our personal feelings, we are reminded to “Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is” (Ephesians 5:15-17).

Lastly, to be as clear and specific as possible, John wrote: “For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him. **Whoever believes** in Him is not condemned, but **whoever does not believe** stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God's one and only Son” (John 3:17-18). The common theme among the passages that refer to salvation is to “**believe.**” There may be passages that we simply don’t understand fully, but if our faith in Jesus as our personal Lord, Savior, and Redeemer is genuine, we will continue to gain more understanding as we read, study, and rely on the Holy Spirit to guide us into all truth.

Don't try to demean The Word of God and The Grace of The Holy Spirit as you had done on the dignified creation of yourself in the Image of God. **The Word of God is embeded by the Inspiration of the Holy Spirit alone in the hearts, minds and bodies of Faithful Believers of The Holy Covenant** whose consummate personifications are Jesus Christ Our Lord and His Holy Mother The Virgin Mary.

I completely disagree with this as I don’t demean the Word of God because I believe in it and I follow it. I can prove this claim by the word of God. On the contrary I can see distortion, deceiving, cozening and deluding on your part. I can also prove this claim by the word of God.

Brother, if you avoid the jargons and put emphasis on the word of God the Holy Spirit will lead you to the truth and you would have woke up from your conceitedness

*Brainwashing and indoctrination* are the devilish tools of manipulation operated by Satan and wicked humans upon other fellow humans of weak

disposition like you. To apply such words to "The Word of God", even by implication, is simply sacrilegious. I pity you for making yourself a product of that evil manoeuvre.

I haven't mentioned indoctrination, but I have mentioned brainwashing by the word of God. Yes I will repeat again, I am brainwashed by the word of God. Yes it is true that if someone is brainwashed by the teaching of men, then it is a sin. But brainwashing by the word of God is salvation, which the devil hates and wants to plant weeds. (Mat 13:25)

*1 Cor 1:1-2 "1 When I came to you, brothers and sisters, I did not come with superior eloquence or wisdom as I proclaimed the testimony of God. 2 For I decided to be concerned about nothing among you **except Jesus Christ, and him crucified**"*

Had you been free from that relentlessly suppressive evil bondage, you wouldn't have acted the way you did so far. This is the FREEDOM that is God-given, and the ONE that we enjoy, through the Inspiration and Guidance of THE SPIRIT OF TRUTH, to explore every domain of Divine Creation and human inventions without any limitation whatsoever. And this is the FREEDOM that ***you are reluctant to accept and scared to death to exercise.***

I don't think you are serious when you write this. For me this is irony. Brother, God's message is pure and simple. If anything is in accordance with the word of God, it is good to read and learn from it. If it is against the word of God, it is a DEMONIC teaching and one has to flee from it. But to reach to this judgment, one need to see and analyze your base teaching, which is ETHIOPIA and ETHIOPIAN HOOD with the word of God. Now if you answer these two questions and it is fully in line with the word of God, I will read the rest of the books you authored. If not, with the end of the world is soon, you better return to the truth and reconcile with God. I think if you go on this, you will not have alibi when you face Christ .

As you are skilled in the art of quoting Biblical verses, the reference from one of the Epistles of St. Paul may perhaps convince you to resort to the books and publications that I persistently urged you to read: **"Test all things; hold fast what is good."** (1Thess. 5/21.)

It is hard to imagine how you don't realize all this time, but the two questions I raised are the TESTS.

From our email correspondence, one could easily deduce a manifestation of a fundamental lack of understanding between your motive and my service. Such unfortunate situation prevails only because the kind of spirit

that dominates and impels you to such degree of intransigence is not compatible with the Holy Spirit that Inspires and Guides our Service of Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God.

I always appalled when you misconstrued the word of God regarding the Holy Spirit in your article. Do you know what the Word of God said about works or role of the Holy Spirit is...

### **THE HOLY SPIRIT'S WORK WITH LOST PEOPLE**

The Holy Spirit work in our hearts to convict us of our sin and show us that, we need to receive Jesus as our Saviour. The Bible says that this is one of the jobs that Jesus sent him to do.

#### **1.) The Holy Spirit tells people that they are lost and need Jesus.**

**John 16:8** *"And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: 9 Of sin, because they believe not on me; 10 Of righteousness, because I go to my Father, and ye see me no more; 11 Of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged."*

To "reprove the world of sin" means that the Holy Spirit tells people that they are sinners and that, as they are, they cannot please a righteous and holy God. You must know that you are a sinner before you can be saved. People who listen to the Holy Spirit are convicted of their wickedness. Then the Holy Spirit will point them to Jesus, not to Ethiopia or Ethiopianhood, but to the only one who can wash away their sins. There was a man like that in the book of Acts. He knew he had to do something about his sin, so he asked Paul and Silas.

**Acts 16:30** *"And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be saved? 31 And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and thou shalt be saved, and thy house".* I can't see any Ethiopia or Ethiopianhood here!!

The Holy Spirit always points to all people (not only Ethiopian) to Jesus, because he is the Saviour that can take away their sins. The worst sin of all is, not believing in Jesus. That is the sin that sends a person to hell forever.

There is another way that the Holy Spirit convicts people of their wickedness. We know that Jesus died to wash our sins away; but he also died so that we could be with God in heaven.

#### **2.) The Holy Spirit shows a lost person that he belongs to the devil and that lost people go to hell when they die.**

**John 8:44a** Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do.

According to the word of God, You and your teaching and the people you claimed to be with you in this bizarre faith of Ethiopianhood, are all belong to somebody. If you don't

belong to God then you belong to the devil. The devil is already judged and will be going to hell. Just as a saved person goes to heaven to be with his heavenly Father, a lost person will go to hell to be with his father, the devil. I'm glad that I'm saved and not going to hell! But I sympathize for you if you don't take the chance while you are on this earth and denounce this bizarre, eccentric and conspicuously or grossly unconventional or unusual teaching.

**John 3:18** He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

**John 3:36** He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

All people are sinners. Sinners who trust Jesus to wash their sins away go to heaven. Sinners who won't believe in Jesus are condemned to go to hell and stay there forever.

### **TRANSITION FROM LOST TO SAVED: THE HOLY SPIRIT BAPTIZES A SAVED PERSON INTO THE BODY OF CHRIST**

**1 Corinthians 12:13a** For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body....

The Holy Spirit puts all people who have trusted Jesus as their Saviour into the Body of Christ. Just as Jesus is inside you if you are saved, you are also inside him. Picture a bathtub full of water. Now in your mind, put an empty jar without a lid into the tub of water. The jar will fill with water and sink to the bottom. The water is in the jar and the jar is in the water. If you are a believer you will be like the jar. If you are saved, Jesus is in you and you are in Jesus. Now put a lot of other different jars in the tub. This is like the body of Christ. It is a family. Every saved person is in the body of Christ and is part of the family. Each one is your brother or sister in the Lord. We don't know our whole family yet, but some day we will meet them all. Did you say you know all your followers who will be saved? What an ominous rumbling?

### **THE HOLY SPIRIT IS 'THE COMFORTER' TO ALL SAVED PEOPLE**

Once a person is saved, the Holy Spirit still deals with him. Jesus called the Holy Spirit the "Comforter."

**John 16:7** It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.

What a wonderful thought! If you are saved there is always someone to comfort and to help you, even if you're all alone.

**2 Corinthians 1:3** Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all comfort; **4** Who comforteth us in all our tribulation.....

No matter what kind of troubles you are going through, you should always pray and tell the Lord. One of the jobs of the Holy Spirit is to comfort you during these times.

## **THE HOLY SPIRIT GUIDES TO THE TRUTH, SPEAKS OF JESUS, TEACHES THE SCRIPTURE, AND HELPS US TO REMEMBER SPIRITUAL THINGS**

Guiding Christians to find the truth and speaking of Jesus are two more jobs the Holy Spirit has. Did you say the Holy Sprit points us to Ethiopia and Ethiopanhood? What an astray!!

**John 16:13** Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

**John 15:26** But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:

The Holy Spirit is called the Spirit of truth because he cannot lie. People lie all the time, even Christians. The Bible says that the devil was a liar from the beginning. **Not only will others lie to you but your own deceitful heart will lie to you, too. It is very important to know what God says about things so that you won't believe any lie from any source.**

**John 14:26** But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

**1 Corinthians 2:13** Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

The Bible can never lead you wrong, but it can't lead you at all if you never open it up. No matter what a friend says, or a preacher says, or a little voice in your mind says - the question is "What does God say?" **The only way you'll know is from your Bible!**

Now the Holy Spirit will also help you to tell others what you have learned about Jesus. That is another one of his jobs. The Lord wants you to tell others, and you have a helper with you all the time.

**John 14:26** But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

## **THE HOLY SPIRIT INSURES ETERNAL SALVATION**

Once a person has trusted Jesus as his personal Saviour, he can never lose his salvation. Jesus never leaves the heart of a person who has asked him to wash away his sins. That is a wonderful thing to know! And it is another job of the Holy Spirit.

**Ephesians 1:13** In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise.

**Ephesians 4:30** And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

### **THE HOLY SPIRIT IS OUR INTERCESSOR - HE PRAYS FOR US**

The last job of the Holy Spirit is that of intercessor. That means he prays for us.

**Romans 8:26** Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

We are certainly not as wise or as smart as God. Sometimes we may pray for things that God knows would not be good for us. When we pray for the wrong things, the Holy Spirit prays too, and tells the Father what would be best. And then sometimes, we don't pray for something that we really need, or maybe we don't even know we need it. If the Holy Spirit sees a trial or trouble coming in our lives, he will pray for us before we even know about it. Remember, the Holy Spirit is God. Isn't it wonderful to know that God prays for what is best for you!

**In short these are the role of the Holy Spirit according to the Word of God. I don't think you can dispute or refute these comments about the role of the Holy Spirit by the word of God. I only see grandiloquence and verbal ornamentation in your article.**

Then, what is the spirit that emboldens you to portray such Fruit of the Service of Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God produced by the Inspiration and Guidance of the Divine Truth Who is Himself The Holy Spirit, as "a myth"? The answer to this interrogative statement must be straightforward: It is the Evil Spirit.

No no, this teaching is not from the Holy Spirit. I already mentioned the main role of the Holy Spirit in the above statement from the bible, and then from where did you get your teaching? If it is not from God then it is from the adversary, who is the DEVIL, who tries to thwart the purpose of God for this world.

*Eph 1:7-10 "In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace **8** that he lavished on us in all wisdom and insight. **9** He did this when he revealed to us the secret of his will, according to his good pleasure that he set forth in Christ, **10 toward the administration of the fullness of the times, to head up all things in Christ – the things in heaven and the things on earth"***

Please read this quote with open hearts, it says to head up **all things** (no Ethiopian or Ethiopianhood here) in Christ. If you are against this, then you are volitionally accepted the teaching of the DEVIL.

The Divine Truth that relates about Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God is not a myth, but a stark REALITY that eternally exists and perpetually

You see, this emphatic assertion is a typical indoctrination and brainwashing, without a doubt, by the demonic spirit of so-called "Ethiopianhood"

Hence, until you pay attention to my advice and find out the same Divine Truth from those books and publications referred to you, yes, the stark REALITY of The Divine Truth that relates about Ethiopia, Ethiopians and Ethipianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God remains and continues **to haunt you as "A MYTH."**

You only get the DIVINE TRUTH from the word of GOD, which is the bible, not from anybody's' writings. **Plain and simple!!**

Unless you prove by answering the two simple questions, not only I but anybody will take your teaching as a MYTH or Fables.

The myth is your own evil perception that your secular mind created for your own consumption by means of which, in the Word of Our Lord, you are **"cast into outer darkness where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth!"** (Matt. 22/1-14)

Please stop these witty and satirical languages! Sorry to say but by misquoting, misrepresenting and manipulating the Word of God, you are ridiculing it instead of using it for building the body of Christ.

Based on The Divine Truth and in consideration of all the statements of facts outlined above, much observations and conclusions could be made. However, on my part, I do not want even to think let alone give any personal judgment on the mental attitude you had towards our Services and manifested in your email contents. To pass such judgment is the domain of The Holy Spirit. Only Our Lord Jesus Christ judges us through The Holy Spirit, now and hereafter, pursuant to His Word that says, **"I am coming..., and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work!"** (Rev. 22/12)

You seem to have short memory, when you write the above statement. Please see what you quote from the bible...

**"Test all things; hold fast what is good."** (1Thess. 5/21.)

*“Now the Bereans were of more noble character than the Thessalonians, for they received the message with great eagerness **and examined the Scriptures every day to see if what Paul said was true.**” Acts 17:11*

By grounding yourself **in the unchanging Word of God** and considering it **your final authority in all matters of faith and practice**, you will have a greater ability to distinguish between true and false teachings and avoid deception.

Otherwise, your continuous impulsive engagement of polemics with our Services would amount to a flagrant confrontation directed against and an act of contempt towards **The Work of The Holy Spirit**. Such conduct of interaction of yours, directed against our Services, in turn, constitutes, in the Word of Our Lord Jesus Christ, **"sin and blasphemy"** and invokes upon yourself the Divine Judgment ordained by Him: The **"sin and blasphemy"** thus committed **"will not be forgiven either in this age or in the age to come."** (Matt. 12/22-32.)

I took this as a vociferous statement. Please study what the real meaning or message of Matt 12:22-23 in context. To help you understand more, compare the quote you underlined with 1 John 1:9

*1 John 1:9 **"But if we confess our sins, he is faithful and righteous, forgiving us our sins and cleansing us from all unrighteousness"***

**Finally I beg you to refrain from diversion and come to our main point of discussion, which is reaching to the truth. If you really have an answer to the raised two questions, please reply with simple language supporting it with the word of God, and then based on your reply, we can go forward. However based on your attitude of your last replies, I doubt if you really have a substantial or practical answer.**

**My prayer to you is that your eyes be opened and see, and the hardening of heart to the truth changed by the real Holy Spirit not the bogus one, who you claimed to be your teacher, which deludes you and others who are in the dark.**

**I hope this will not be our last email exchange. I want to hear more from you.**

## **Our Response to the Fifth Email from S. Girmatsion:**

I acknowledge receipt of your email that is full of redundancy as usual.

1. In our last response to you, I notified you categorically not to write us if you are not genuinely interested to learn and know about the Divine Truth on Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of The Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God That is wholly protected and provided, inspired and guided by The Holy Spirit under The Divine Sovereignty of the Priestly Kingship of Our Lord Jesus Christ and the Maternal Queenship of Our Lady The Virgin Mary. But you did not seem to comply with that call at all.
2. Our answers to your “**two questions**” were and are still positive and straightforward. Yes, they are answered even in a more expanded and satisfying way than you would like them to be presented. Such hints were provided continuously in my previous responses; and if you needed to ascertain or realize such affirmation you were repeatedly advised to refer to the books and publications posted on our various website forums. You were also told, time after time, that these materials are written and compiled **solely based on and supported by Biblical quotations** meant for decent people who are genuinely interested in the sacred subject-matter with which you are already familiarized. Even if I tried to be magnanimous in my dealings with you in the past by presenting to you what you asked for, **I could not close this matter simply by quoting two or three relevant verses from the Bible just to satisfy your whim.**

It is quite evident that, as demonstrated in your persistent intransigence, the spirit of the adversary of God hinders you so far from reading those books and publications we referred to you so many a time and whose contents are all entirely replete with quotations that derived **only from Scriptures**. As a result, you are deprived of the good chance to learn and know more deeply and extensively about Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God that would bestow upon you the Divine Privilege of being a True Ethiopian, a True Ag’azi, a True Amhara, or a True Christian. (Please note here the seniority of Ethiopianhood as it precedes all the rest in its existence and the inherent connotation of FREEDOM all the terms carry.)

3. After all these extensive exchanges of emails, your last communication suggests that you still remained intransigent, despite all our efforts to bring you to your senses, which sadly seem to end up in futility. Under this circumstance, it looks like you chose again to be identified with one of those enthusiast catechumen, fanatic converts, or brainwashed apostates that emerge within different religious sects, especially out of Protestantism, the so-called Christian Fundamentalists or Born Again. These are the ones who are prone to be easily agitated, obsessed and

blinded by their newly acquired destructive passion and embark in no time upon an exercise of lecturing and imposing their newly acquired belief on everybody they come across by quoting and misquoting a mass of biblical verses with the end aim to proselytize that person.

If this is not the case, you may be identified again with those hardline Jews whose intransigence drove them to hatred and jealousy that culminated in their murder of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

Here is a relevant verse from the Word of Our Lord that is pertinent to the issue in question, and with which He rebuked the intransigent Jews of His Time who behaved and acted just like you:

**“You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me. But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life. ...Why do you not understand My speech? Because you are not able to listen to My Word. You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in The Truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it. But because I tell The Truth, you do not believe Me. (Jn. 5/39-40; 8/43-45.)**

4. None of the Biblical quotations that you amassed in the series of your emails do we reject but accept in their entirety, provided that they are quoted, applied and interpreted appropriately in their context. You have been told in each of our responses that Biblical quotations are the basic references to our Ethiopian Faith of The Holy Covenant and, as such, of Ethiopia: The Kingdom of God.

However, almost all of your quotations directly or indirectly point not to us, as you meant them to be, but to your own devious religious attitude and behaviour. Thus, surprisingly and most significantly, they apply to the evil objective of destructive nature you are currently pursuing against the aforementioned Ethiopian subject matter.

No wonder, a renegade who admitted, in preference to the inspiration of The Holy Spirit, being brainwashed by anti-Ethiopian foreign religious powers and renounced his Ethiopian Christian Faith in which he was born from God through The Holy Spirit in Baptism and converted into the so-called Born-Again Sect turn out to be so impulsive, aggressive and intransigent.

5. Throughout your emails at several instances and more often than not, you expressed your emotional bewilderment that engulfed you whenever a phenomenal or mysterious feature that is unknown or new to you was revealed to you in our responses concerning The Divine Truth about

Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God.

This is not something that is strange in the Service of The Holy Covenant after all. The Jews of Jesus's time showed the same sentiment, to the extent of labeling Him as someone who was *“out of his mind”* or *“possessed by the demons”*, only because what He said and did were unpalatable to them. Scriptures verify this fact in the following terms: **“But when His own people heard about this, they went out to lay hold of Him, for they said, ‘He is out of His mind’. And the scribes who came down from Jerusalem said, ‘He has Beelzebub, and, by the ruler of the demons He casts out the demons.’”** (Mark 3/21-22.)

Even when His Apostles **“were all filled with The Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, ...the multitude were all confused, amazed, marveled and perplexed. ...Others mockingly said, ‘They are full of new wine!’”**

Also, when Saint Paul spoke to the Athenians, the same happened: **“And, when they heard of the resurrection of the dead, some mocked, while others said, ‘we will hear you again on this matter’”**. (Act. 2/4-13, 17/32.)

6. Don't you realize how you are being manipulated by those foreign powers who are themselves the tools of the Devil, who brainwashed you in their hate for Ethiopia and who are determined to destroy Her and everything that is Ethiopian through your effective instrumentality to their sinister campaign of domination? Why do they want you, use you and urge you to focus on Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God alone?

Why do they designate you to concentrate and expend your time, energy and resources on the aforementioned campaign they perpetrated for the destruction of Ethiopia and everything that is Ethiopian? Why did they preferred to be engaged in such malicious campaign, rather than going out to and reaching out the unbelievers: the gentiles and pagans, the Jews and the Muslims and the Godless and the idolators, the seculars and the anti-christs with the aim to evangelize them?

If you feel so fanatical about your new religion of Born-Again Christian Fundamentalism, go to and approach the above cited unbelievers and provide them with those quotations and make them to accept your Gospel rather than bothering The Ethiopians of The Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God who conveyed and **“preached for milleniums and to this day The Good Tidings of The Divine Truth to the whole world and every creature”** including your religious mentors who came into their existence most recently.

This reality remains manifest right from the beginning of the time of Adam and Eve transmitted through generations of Henok and Noah, MelchiZedeq, Abraham, Moses and David, right to the end of Time of Jesus Christ and The virgin Mary and even to this day that continues into eternity.

7. Even if we repeatedly tried to explain to you (but which you found hard to grasp), let me reiterate the simple and distinct reason why we maintained the designation of Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of The Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God over Which Jesus Christ and The Virgin Mary reign:

It is because The Divine Truth proclaims the entities of Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood as the only embodiment of The Holy Covenant that enshrined the Seven Covenants that God made with humans from the time of Adam and Eve to that of Jesus Christ and The Virgin Mary even to this day that spans a 7, 502 years of age in Biblical calendar computation.

As to the question of why the Ge'ez or Ethiopic word of "Ethiopia" was given preeminence over all the others and elected for such designation, the answer lies in the fact that the creation and the usage as well as the existence of the word "Ethiopia" predates those of all the world's languages, names, nations, religions, civilizations, philosophies and ideologies, including those of the Gentiles, the Jews and the Christian ones in general, and the Nigerian or the Chinese ones you cited in your emails as examples in particular.

8. Here is another crucial point that needs to be raised and dealt with in connection with this Divine Truth: What was the name used to address "The Children of God" as a group of people or as a nation long before the Jews or Hebrews or Israelites came to exist?

What was the term employed to distinguish the unbroken religious norm that Adam and Eve and their descendants upto their legitimate heir Noah and his inheritor MelchiZedeq followed and practiced before the inception of Judaism that was realized by the initiation of the new convert renamed Abraham into the preexisting faith mentioned in the foregoing? How were "The Children of God" identified from the rest of humanity until Judaism let alone Christianity was introduced?

The Divine Truth that emanates the fundamental, traditional and prevailing convention of our Faith of The Holy Covenant testifies and ordains that the terms utilized were "Ethiopian" and "Ethiopians" which appellation served them as an identification that derived from the inheritor and conveyor of The Holy Covenant and Pioneer of Ethiopianhood, Founder of Jerusalem and Mentor of Abraham, whose name was EthioPis and whose priestly kingship title as a True Believer and Worshipper of the Most High God was MelchiZedeq.

9. This is Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopiawinnet (Ethiopianhood, Ethiopianness, Ethiopianism or Ethiopianity) of The Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God that are consummately and eternally personified by The Holy Virgin Mary and Her Son the Incarnate God, Jesus Christ, and that which we related about so far in our responses to your emails.

Yes, this is Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopiawinnet of The Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God about Which Our Lord Jesus Christ spoke highly when He said, **“The queen of the South will rise up in the judgment with this generation and condemn it, for she came from the ends of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and indeed a greater than Solomon is here.”** (Matt. 12/42.)

It is understandable from your point of view why and how you overlooked and failed to comprehend the obvious fact and the stark reality that the mention by Jesus Christ of the Queen of the South was made in reference to Ethiopia. The same notion applies to how you would react when you learn of The Divine Truth that stipulates for a person to become not only a new member into Christianity to be called “a Christian” but also “an Ethiopian” when he TRULY BELIEVES in (“accepts” in your terms) Jesus Christ, and completed the sacrament of Baptism. He will be transformed into being **“the New Man which was Created according to God, in True Righteousness and Holiness, renewed in the Spirit of the Mind.”** according to Saint Paul. (Eph. 4/23-24.)

As an Ethiopian, that person, taken aback to the days that preceded the advent of Christianity as well as that of Judaism, enjoys the Eternal Life and Heavenly Fellowship in the Faith and Assembly of the Righteous and the Saints where the loyal Partners and Custodians of the Holy Covenant that started with Adam and Eve and, passing through Noah, MelchiZedeq, Abraham, and going down to Moses and David that ended up with The Holy Virgin Mary and The Lord Jesus Christ are all convened and participate.

What a Privileged Divine Blessing and Joy, Honour and Pride is it for that individual who becomes and calls himself “Ethiopian” and claims to be so!

I hope you will always be mindful of the reality that the Transcendental and the Omnipotent Work of The Holy Spirit is a source of perpetual and ongoing process of providence to our individual lives as well as to the survival of the whole Universe. If you recognize this Divine Truth, I am sure you will refrain from restricting yourself to the past only for which you hastily attempt to produce a Biblical quotation, and will acquire courage to bring yourself out from the intransigence of

backwardness into the present outlook of progressive future where great expectation and optimism prevail.

10. But I doubt your brainwashed and corrupt mind would bear all the foregoing and ongoing presentations in this as well as in the previous responses let alone understand and accept them, except, of course, by your willingness and readiness to receive the Grace of Repentance.

If you still could not understand the nature of our vocation in which we are engaged and come to terms with us by discharging your obligation to comply with it accordingly, we will be obliged to conclude that there is an intrinsic and ulterior motive on your part that only The Holy Spirit knows and resolves.

Under such circumstance, we wish to sum up our dealings with you in the following Word of God: **“But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know *them*, because they are spiritually discerned. But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is *rightly* judged by no one. For “*who has known the mind of the LORD that he may instruct Him?*” But we have the mind of Christ.”** (1Cor. 2/14-16.)

11. As was the correspondence, so also “*the diversion from the main point of discussion*” was initiated by you, not by us. It resulted from your refusal to heed to my recommendation stated previously several times.

However, I deduce from your email which ends in the following sentences of **“I hope this will not be our last email exchange.”** and **“I want to hear more from you”** that you seem to be interested in continuing our email correspondence that concerns the aforementioned sacred subject-matter, and in your own word, **“our main point of discussion, which is reaching to the truth.”** Here, I hope you mean **THE “REAL” DIVINE TRUTH, “not the bogus [the evil and the human] one, whom you claimed to be your teacher, which deludes you and others who are in the dark”**, again to quote from your own closing remark.

Thanks to your persistence, I had the opportunity to provide you further material which would serve you as a means and as another chance for your True Redemption through The Holy Spirit in Jesus Christ the Incarnate God born of The Virgin Mary. The foregoing expressions of goodwill are good signs of a prospective healthy outcome of our interaction.

12. Let me repeat this assertion, based on your own quotation and statement that read:

a) *“Now the Bereans were of more noble character than the Thessalonians, for they received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day to see if what Paul said was true.”*  
Acts 17:11

That is exactly what we required of you to accomplish when I quoted for you the verse: **“Test all things; hold fast what is good.”** (1Thess. 5/21.) I am still asking you to be like the Bereans or follow their exemplary virtue and act by being *“of more noble character than [your likes], for they [ You as the Bereans] receive the message with great eagerness and examine the Scriptures every day [that I quoted in those books and publications] to see if what [I] said [about Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God] was true.”*

b) **“By grounding yourself in the unchanging Word of God and considering it your final authority in all matters of faith and practice, you will have a greater ability to distinguish between true and false teachings and avoid deception.”**

Again, that is exactly what we had done and pleaded with you repeatedly to follow suit: To read my books and publications in which only Biblical quotations are employed as references to verify the Message of The Divine Truth that relates about Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of the Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God.

13. Despite those factual situations mentioned previously, and in consideration of the foregoing inviting gestures of yours, we do not want to let you down and abandon you in the dark wilderness of ignorance and of evil bondage. This is not our mission.

Our Mission is to reach those victims of the evil bondage of darkness and ignorance on Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and Ethiopianhood of The Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God, especially the intransigent ones, and bring them out into The Light and Freedom of The Divine Knowledge of Truth. Of course, this noble commitment is abhorred so inherently by “the father of lie” and the embodiment of darkness, the source of ignorance and the executioner of bondage, as well as the perpetrator of all evils, including intransigence.

14. Thus, for your own sake and salvation, let me give you an extract from those books and publications that we recommended to you to read but which you refused to comply with. This extract epitomizes the sacred subject-matter that we are discussing about with the prospect of enlightening you and defining to you all about what the Name of Ethiopia connotes, who the Ethiopians are and what Ethiopianhood stands for. It is

the core of THE FAITH on which the inception and existence of Ethiopia, the Ethiopians and the Ethiopianhood of The Holy Covenant and, as such, of The Kingdom of God is founded in time immemorial, and by the preservation of which the latter uniquely survived all the vicissitudes of the whole Biblical Era of 7,502 years to this day with the inevitability of going on into eternity.

I hope you will resort to the God-given (and not the human indocrination) spiritual guts of yourself to read them in your untainted personal disposition of clean heart and clear mind wherein The Holy Spirit dwells. Make a taste of those books and publications that you were urged constantly to peruse, but which invitation you persistently refused to accept.

No doubt, if not you, a decent person will find them like **“the little book which is open in the hand of the Angel who set his right foot on the sea and his left foot on the land.**

**“The voice which I heard from Heaven spoke to me again, and said, ‘Go, take the little book which is open in the hand of the Angel who stands on the sea and on the earth!’**

**“So, I went to the Angel and said to him, ‘Give me the little book!’.**

**“And he said to me, ‘Take and eat it ; and it will make your stomach bitter, but it will be as sweet as honey in your mouth.’**

**“Then I took the little book out of the Angel’s hand and ate it; and it was as sweet as honey in my mouth. But when I had eaten it, my stomach became bitter.**

**“And he said to me, ‘You must prophesy again about many peoples, nations, tongues and kings.’” (Rev. 10/1-11.)**

15. Here are the extracts:-

### **THE ETHIOPIAN CREED**

We Ethiopians believe in One God, God the Father, Almighty who possesses all, Maker of the Heavens and Earth, the visible and the invisible.

We believe in God the Son, Jesus Christ, One Lord, the only begotten Son of the Father, who was with Him before the creation of the world. He is Light from Light, True God from True God, begotten not made, and, in His Divine Essence, one with His Father. All things were made by Him, and without Him nothing whatsoever was made, in Heavens or on Earth.

He came down from Heavens for our sake, for the sake of humanity, for our salvation. He was Incarnate in the womb of the Virgin Mary

by the Divine Work of the Holy Spirit, and, acquiring the human soul and the human flesh from Her, became the Perfect Man.

In the days of Pontius Pilate, He suffered, was crucified, died and was buried for our sake. And He rose from the dead on the third day, ascended in glory into Heaven and sat on His Throne at the right-hand of His Father.

He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead. There is no end to His Kingdom.

We believe in God the Holy Spirit. He is the life-giving Spirit who proceeds from God the Father, spoke through the Prophets, and, by the atonement of Jesus Christ, descended upon the Apostles and filled the world with His Grace. We worship and glorify Him with the Father and the Son.

We believe in the One Church of The Holy Covenant that was founded by the Word of God, Jesus Christ, initially in the Hearts of the Patriarchs, and later sustained by His Divine Messages through the Prophets, and finally brought to perfection through the Holy Spirit by His convocation of the Apostles, and where His Body and Blood is offered as Sacrifice for the Holy Communion with God, and where the Sacramental Blessings of the Holy Spirit are bestowed upon and communicated to all believers.

We believe in One Baptism for the remission of sins.

We believe in the Resurrection from the dead and the Life to come, world without end. Amen.

## **THE TESTIMONIAL OF THE ETHIOPIANS**

### **ON THE HOLY COVENANT**
